

# Aloe Vera Peel

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Doctor D. Schwab's most results oriented professional botanical peel is an alternative to harsh Glycolic Peels. Contains an active blend of naturally effective, botanically based Alpha Hydroxy Fruit Acids (AHA), including Lactic and Malic Acid, from fruit sources. Alpha Hydroxy Fruit Acids are found to be the most effective acids to be used for peels since their molecules are the smallest among all acids and penetrate easily into the skin.

Non-irritating, it features an Aloe Vera base. The creamy formulation gently microexfoliates the skin and rebalances moisture loss. It has the ability to penetrate the upper layer of the skin to remove dead skin cells and stimulate new skin cell growth. Fruit acids are at a 20% concentration and a pH of 3.5.

**Peel with Natural Fruit Acids** | Malic and Lactic Acids from botanically based Alpha Hydroxy Fruit Acids improve skin texture by sloughing away dead skin cells and promoting collagen growth to reduce fine lines and wrinkles and even out skin tone. Malic Acid is from fermented apples and Lactic Acid is from fermented milky plants.

### **USAGE:**

#### FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY!

Cleanse skin. Apply Aloe Vera Peel to the face, neck and décolleté with a q-tip or a mask brush, starting on the side of the face, then moving to the forehead and cheeks, then the nose, lips and neck. Avoid the eye area. DO NOT APPLY VAPOR WITH PEEL.

Leave to take effect for 2-5 minutes depending on the client's sensitivity, then gently remove with tepid water and a sponge in a last-in-first-out process. After removing the peel, perform a second cleansing to neutralize any remaining acid. Follow with Toner, Serum, and Moisturizer. Clients can return later in the week for a hydrating facial and should b advised on a good 'home care' regimen.

#### **NOTES:**

- Before performing the treatment, we recommend that you do a patch test to determine if your client is sensitive or has an allergic reaction to the Alpha Hydroxy Fruit Acids.
- Inform the client that if they are using an AHA product at home, they should discontinue the use of it for 72 hours before and after.
- Do not perform any other exfoliation during the treatment.
